What is a Minglespace?

A Minglespace is a connection spot—a clearly marked table or area in coffee shops, breweries, parks, universities, festivals, and more—where anyone is invited to say hi to someone they haven't met yet.

People can scan the sign, pick a fun prompt, and spark an easy chat whether they're solo, new to town, traveling, or out with friends.

Why create a Minglespace?

A Minglespace offers a simple, visible way to invite connection. Placing a sign on a table or in a shared area signals: "Here, talking is welcome."

Built-in prompts remove the pressure of small talk, so locals, newcomers, and travelers can choose to chat, share ideas, or simply say hello.

This small addition can turn an ordinary visit into an opportunity for connection—and over time, help your place feel more welcoming, spark return visits, and strengthen community around your space.

How does participation work?

Apply on our participation page to get started. Complete your place's profile. Download our sign files for free for your own printing solution or order signs from us. Once the signs arrive, place the main sign at a central table, bar, or designated area — somewhere visible that signals this is an open, place-supported feature, not a private event.
