MingleSpace Org Enlists Everyday Places to Take the Lead on Social Connection

Now inviting businesses and organizations of all kinds to participate for free and help build a national network of MingleSpaces

Milwaukee, WI (August 4, 2025) – Today, MingleSpace Org launches a national campaign enlisting everyday places to take the lead on social connection by creating MingleSpaces—connection spots where anyone is invited to say hi. After a year of pilots in seven breweries, four cafés, a park installation, Oktoberfest, and a number of music venues, the nonprofit has refined its prompt library, signs, and overall experience and is now ready to scale. A member download page lets any café, museum, university, or other places get signs and launch a MingleSpace. The first milestone is 1,000 MingleSpaces by Dec. 2026, on the way to 10,000 sites nationwide by 2030.

What is a MingleSpace?

A MingleSpace is a designated connection spot, a social table or area marked by a sign where anyone can stop by and say hi. Scanning the sign's QR code opens 100+ conversation prompts organized into progressive levels of depth— from icebreakers to imagination challenges, brainstorming local projects to sharing personal dreams— along with place-specific topics and mini-activities. People can post anonymous highlights and MingleSpace summarizes recurring themes, shared back with the host community to inspire new collaborations.

Why MingleSpaces?

MingleSpace Org envisions a future where nearly every public place offers a dedicated connection spot, an expected piece of social infrastructure that sparks spontaneous conversation.

Everyday Opportunities for Connection

 Meeting new people shouldn't require an event or an app; a clearly marked spot in places people already visit invites anyone to stop by and say hi.

Places Lead the Way

 By adding a MingleSpace sign that encourages introductions, places take the first step toward connecting the people who gather there, making it easy to start a conversation.

Stronger Communities, Less Isolation

 Spontaneous conversations build trust, spark new ideas, and turn strangers into neighbors, amplifying creativity and reducing loneliness.

How Places Join

- 1. Sign up: Go to <u>MingleSpace.org/participate</u> and complete a short profile.
- Download & Print: Get free PDFs for table signs, Aframes, or banners and send to a local printer.
- 3. Display: Install your sign in a high-traffic spot, central table, or any gathering area.
